2nd Souke Meitatsu Yagi, Sensei

2nd Souke Master Meitatsu Yaqi, 10th Dan is the eldest son of the late Grand Master Dai Sensei Meitoku Yagi founder and 1st Souke of Meibukan Gojyu-Ryu. Souke Meitatsu Yagi began his training under his father in 1949 at the age of five years old, he didn't read books or watch training videos to gain his expertise in Karate. He was being tutored directly by Dai Sensei Meitoku Yagi. By training under his only teacher, his father, for over fifty years, he was groomed and trained to carry on the legacy of Meibukan Gojyu-Ryu Karate. One of Souke Meitatsu Yagi's goals has been to spread Meibukan Gojyu-Ryu Karate throughout the world whenever possible. This being said, Souke Meitatsu Yagi has lived, worked, initiated new dojos and taught Meibukan Gojyu-Ryu outside of Okinawa and around the world.

Souke Meitatsu Yagi lived in the US from 1964 to 1970; in Guam 1971 to 1975; in Saipan 1995 to 1997 and in the Philippines 1997 to 1998.



Hanshi Akihito Yagi, Sensei

Akihito Yagi, Hanshi, 9th Dan, is the oldest son of Souke Meitatsu Yagi Sensei. He began training in Karate at the age of three. First under his grandfather, and then later under his father. He is the current President of the IMGKA. Continuing the work begun by his father, Hanshi Akihito Yagi travels all over the world to teach seminars on traditional Meibukan Gojyu-Ryu Karate. He has a teaching style that reflects his affection for others, growing and learning together.

Alongside his father, Hanshi Akihito Yagi is the current General Secretary of the Okinawa Karate Kobudo Association and has recently been voted into a second term with this organization.

Hanshi Akihito Yagi has been assisting promoting tourism in Japan and has been working with both Japan Tourism on various projects promoting Okinawa and Japan around the world.

Hanshi Akihito Yagi is not only a great martial artist but also a lover of music and all things Elvis. He has been a past spokesperson for Orion Beer as well. Of most notoriety he was one of the stars of the movie "Kuro Obi-Black Belt", as well as the author of the children's book "Karate Man".



VILA NOVA DE GAIA

Vila Nova de Gaia is a municipality belonging to the Metropolitan Area of Porto. Located in the district of Porto, the city is in the Northern Region of Portugal.

With 300.000 inhabitants it is the most populated municipality in the North Region and one of the most populated municipalities in the country.

Vila Nova de Gaia has been known nationally and internationally for its Porto wine companies for centuries. However, other industries (cars and glass) help the municipality to be acknowledge due to their economic weight.

Vila Nova de Gaia is also a land of artists. Sculptors as Soares dos Reis (n. 1847- f. 1889), and Teixeira Lopes (n. 1866- f. 1942); writers as Maria Alberta Menéres (n. 1930 – f. 2019), and Diogo de Macedo (n. 1889- f. 1959) are key figures of portuguese culture, born in the municipality.

Some athletes from Vila Nova de Gaia have also distinguished themselves by their brilliant careers. Cases such as Vanessa Fernandes (Olympic triathlete medalist), her father Venceslau Fernandes (winner of Volta a Portugal, Cycling Tour at 39 years old) and Vítor Baía (former international goalkeeper and one of the players with most trophies won in the world).





WHAT TO VISIT

Vila Nova de Gaia has a privileged geographical location, with over 15km of Atlantic coastline and almost 2 dozen beaches distinguished with "Blue Flag" for their environmental quality.

The Riverside area, on the south bank of the Douro River, in front of the city of Porto, is the welcome card of the district and must-see site. Here, you can find the well know Port wine cellars and know more about its history.













PORTO AIRPORT

The International Airport Francisco Sá Carneiro is about 20km away of the event venue, Pavilhão da Escola Almeida Garrett – Vila Nova de Gaia. It should take you around 20min to reach by car, taxi, or uber. There is also the possibility to catch the subway.
